This event is for all junior chess players in the Devon area or elsewhere.

The Cup will be awarded to the best Devon pair and there will be year group trophies.

 REGISTRATION is at 1.15pm and PLAY will start at 1.30pm. The day will finish at about 5.00pm after the prize giving; this will be as soon as possible after the last round finishes.


 TIME CONTROL is 12 minutes per player per game; there will be 6 rounds. All players will play in all rounds (except for byes).


 Please ENTER WITH A PARTNER to avoid the risk of being without a partner at the event. UNPAIRED ENTRANTS will be paired before the event if possible.


 DIRECTIONS: The Kenn Centre is at the North end of Kennford, next to Partridge Cycles, with easy access from the A38. There is ample free car parking.

RULES of EXCHANGE CHESS (2016)

1. Players play in teams of two against other pairs; White and Black play against Black and White.

2. Captured pieces are passed to your partner straight away; the pieces you receive will be the same colour as your pieces on your board.

3. Instead of making a move on your board, you can 'drop' any captured piece onto any vacant square, except that pawns may not be dropped onto the first or the eighth rank. Pieces can be held 'in hand' behind your first rank and must not be hidden from your opponent.

4. Pieces can be dropped to give check.

5. A piece can be dropped to give checkmate.

6. Mate on either board ends the game.

7. Flag fall on either board ends the game.

8. 12 minutes are allowed for each player for the game. Clocks (0 0) should be placed at each end so that all four players can see the time on both clocks. Partners can remind each other about pressing their clocks.

9. Players can advise partners about pieces they would find useful. Please try to do this with minimum, and not maximum, volume.

10. Touch move and touch take do not apply; pressing the clock completes a move.

11. The decision of the arbiter, however unfair, is final.

Black wins on the left-hand board by dropping a Queen with check onto d2; the Queen must be taken by the Bishop, then the original Black Queen comes down to give mate.
